### Offensive Player of the Week

Appalachian State running back **Kevin Richardson** (Elizabethtown, N.C.) earned SoCon Offensive Player of the Week honors. Richardson rushed for a career-best 215 yards on 22 carries and scored touchdowns on runs of 4, 42 and 4 yards in a 79-35 win over Western Carolina to retain the Old Mountain Jug.



### Defensive Player of the Week

Furman outside linebacker **Julian Hicks** (Atlanta, Ga.) earned SoCon Defensive Player of the Week recognition. Making his first career start, Hicks recorded a team and career high 11 tackles to lead the Paladins to a 24-22 win at 11th-ranked Georgia Southern. The Furman defense limited the Eagles to 170 yards on the ground, half the team's average (341).



### Special Teams Player of the Week

Wofford's **Sean Lees** (Libertyville, Ill.) was named SoCon Special Teams Player of the Week. Lees returned three kickoffs for a total of 115 yards in a 42-16 triumph at Chattanooga. Lees returned a kickoff 79 yards for a touchdown in the fourth quarter, as the Terriers put the game out of reach.



### Freshman Player of the Week

The Citadel quarterback **Bart Blanchard** (Rock Hill, S.C.) was named Southern Conference Freshman of the Week. Blanchard completed 22-of-29 passes for 370 yards and three scores in a 42-31 victory over Elon. Blanchard's 370 passing yards ranked as the third best performance by a Bulldog quarterback in The Citadel annals.





## SoCon Tie-Breaker System

With a 42-16 victory at Chattanooga on Nov. 10, Wofford moved into first place in the Southern Conference and claimed the league's automatic qualifier for the FCS Playoffs. Appalachian State would share the conference crown if it defeats Chattanooga on Nov. 17. Wofford earned the automatic qualifier for the playoffs having defeated Appalachian State, 42-31, on Sept 22 in head-to-head competition.

### 8.0 Tie-Breaker Policy

8.1 Regular season champions are the teams posting the best win-loss percentage or points (soccer) against Conference opponents.

8.2 In the event of identical percentages, preference is given to the team playing the most conference games.

8.3 Co-champions are declared if teams post identical records.

8.4 Seeding. The following are the conference's tie-breaking criteria unless otherwise noted in each respective set of sport regulations

**8.4.1 - In the event of a tie, the first tie-breaking decision is based on head to head competition. If one team has defeated the other teams in head to head competition, preference is given to the winner of the competition.**

**8.4.2 - In the event of multiple ties, preference is given to the team with the best record against the tied teams during regular season competition.**

8.4.3 - If a tie still remains, competition against the highest placed team not involved in the tie.

8.4.4 - If a tie still remains, the process is continued from highest placed team down until the tie is broken.

8.4.5 - In all cases, seeding is done by resolving the higher seeds first and working down.

8.4.6 - If a tie cannot be resolved as described above, the Commissioner will have a coin toss.

## New NCAA Terminology

The NCAA has adopted new terminology to define NCAA football-playing institutions. The NCAA has eliminated I-A and I-AA designations.

The Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) includes teams that participate in the 32 post-season bowl system. The Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) includes programs (such as those in the Southern Conference) that participate in the NCAA postseason playoff system.

FBS teams are permitted 85 scholarships and FCS teams have a limit of 63 scholarships.

When the revised rules regarding the play clock went into effect this year, many thought game times would increase. Rules changes for the 2007 season include moving kickoffs from the 35-yard line to the 30 to increase kickoff returns; the clock starts on kickoffs when the ball is touched by a member of the return team. The clock will stop following a first down rather than when the kicking team makes contact with the ball.
