### Offensive Player of the Week

For the third time this season, Elon quarterback **Scott Riddle** (Ramseur, N.C.) was named SoCon Offensive Player of the Week. He completed 36-of-51 passes for 359 yards and three scores as Elon topped Chattanooga, 38-28. Riddle set Elon single-season records for completions (254), passing yards (2,606) and touchdown passes (23). He has thrown for 300 or more yards in seven consecutive games.



### Defensive Player of the Week

Appalachian State safety **Corey Lynch** (Cape Coral, Fla.) earned SoCon Defensive Player of the Week honors. The senior made 12 tackles, broke up a pass and intercepted a pass on the three-yard line on the final play of the game as the Mountaineers slipped past Furman, 34-27. Lynch is just the third player in Appalachian State history with 20 career interceptions.



### Special Teams Player of the Week

Georgia Southern place kicker **Jesse Hartley** (Tallahassee, Fla.) was named SoCon Special Teams Player of the Week. He booted field goals of 23 and 20 yards and converted an extra point as the Eagles earned a come-from-behind 21-17 victory over The Citadel. It marks the second time this season the junior has earned Special Teams Player of the Week honors.



### Freshman Player of the Week

Western Carolina wide receiver **Marquel Pittman** (Maxton, N.C.) was named Southern Conference Freshman of the Week. Pittman caught six passes for 124 yards and two scores as Wofford defeated Western Carolina, 48-44, on Thursday night. His TD receptions included catches of 29 and 27 yards. His acrobatic fourth quarter grab brought the Catamounts to 47-44.

### 2007 Rule Changes

Rules changes for the 2007 season include moving kickoffs from the 35-yard line to the 30 to increase kickoff returns; the clock starts on kickoffs when the ball is touched by a member of the return team. The clock will stop following a first down rather than when the kicking team makes ball contact.

### New NCAA Terminology

The NCAA has adopted new terminology to define NCAA football-playing institutions. The NCAA has eliminated I-A and I-AA designations. The Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) includes teams that participate in the 32 post-season bowl system. The Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) includes programs (such as those in the Southern Conference) that participate in the NCAA postseason playoff system. FBS teams are permitted 85 scholarships and FCS teams have a limit of 63.
