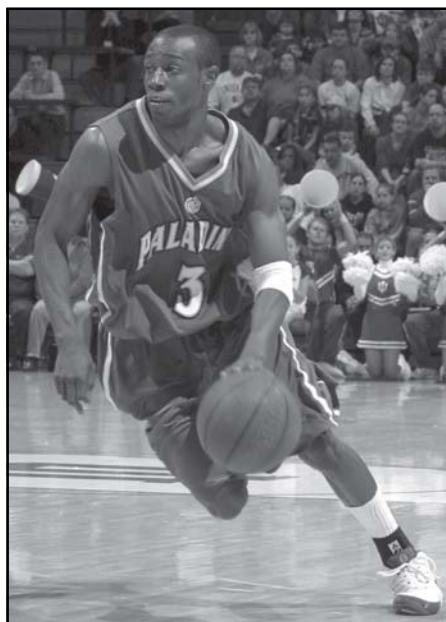

Paladin Notebook

•Furman posted a 16-13 overall record and finished fourth in the South Division with a 9-7 league record. It marked the first time since the 1990-91 and 1991-92 seasons that the Paladins put together back-to-back winning seasons. It also marked Furman's third straight season of a .500 or better season in conference play.

•The Paladins return four starters and six letterwinners from a year ago, led by Moussa Diagne. Diagne grabbed third-team all-conference accolades from the SoCon media as a sophomore in 2005 after averaging a team-high 12.3 ppg -- 15th in the league in scoring. He also pulled down a team-best 5.3 rebounds per contest and connected on 50.5 percent of his shots from the floor.

•Other starters back for Furman include Robby Bostain (11.1 ppg), Eric Webb (10.8) and Tony Carter (9.2). In addition to all three nearly averaging 10 points a game, the trio also each dished out better than 90 assists.

•As a team, the Paladins set a school record with 267 3-point field goals and ranked fifth in the nation averaging 9.2 treys per game. Eric Webb led the team with 77 3-pointers, the fourth-highest output in the league a year ago.

FACTS WORTH KNOWING

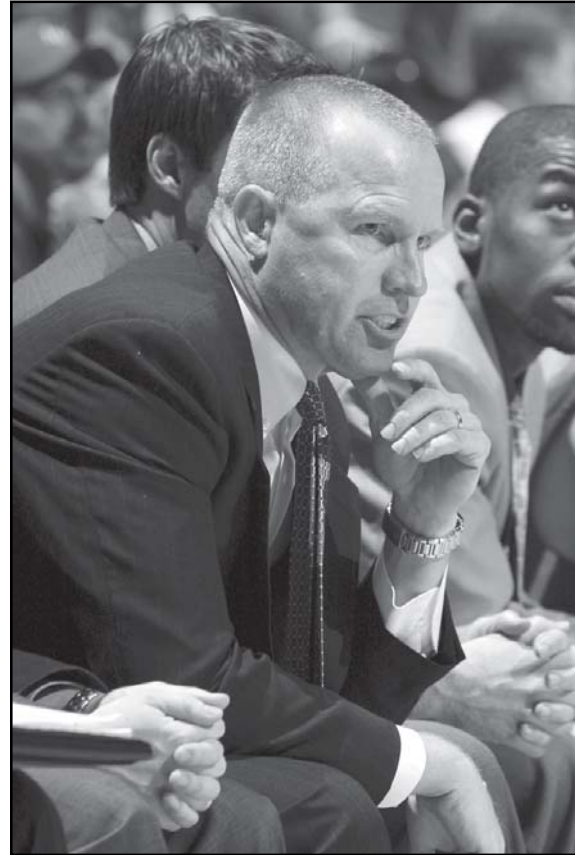

In 1996-97, Minnesota won the Big Ten Conference championship with a 16-2 record and posted a school record 31-4 overall mark en route to an appearance in the NCAA Final Four. While at Wake Forest, Davis played a key role in the revitalization of the Demon Deacon program under Dave Odom.
