### Offensive Players of the Week

GSU quarterback **Jayson Foster** (Canton, Ga.) and ASU quarterback **Trey Elder** (Duncan, S.C.) were named SoCon Offensive Players of the Week. Foster rushed for 231 yards and three TDs in a 45-21 win over West Georgia. He completed 6-of-9 passes for 124 yards. Elder completed 9-of-13 passes for 210 yards and four TDs and rushed for 90 yards and a TD in a 48-7 win vs. Lenoir-Rhyne.

### Defensive Player of the Week

Wofford linebacker **Gary Blount** (St. Mary's, Ga.) was named Southern Conference Defensive Player of the Week. A sophomore, Blount intercepted two passes and recorded a game-high six tackles for the Terriers. Wofford posted a 52-24 victory over Charleston Southern at Gibbs Stadium in Spartanburg, S.C. to improve to 2-0 on the season.

### Special Teams Player of the Week

The Citadel's **Johnathan Synovec** (Columbia, S.C.) was named Southern Conference Special Teams Player of the Week. The freshman walk-on recorded two blocked punts as a member of the Bulldog's special team. The Bulldogs turned one of the blocks into a field goal. The Citadel posted a 76-0 victory over Webber International recording the most points in nearly a century.

### Freshman Player of the Week

Elon quarterback **Scott Riddle** (Ramseur, N.C.) was named Southern Conference Freshman of the Week for the second time this season. The freshman completed 23-of-34 passes for 362 yards and three touchdowns in Elon's 59-16 victory over West Virginia Wesleyan.

Appalachian State was featured on the cover of *Sports Illustrated* on Sept. 10 after posting a 34-32 victory over No. 5-ranked Michigan on Sept. 1. It marked the 25th time since 1982 that a Southern Conference team had beaten a FBS team.

### Mountaineers Earn 19 Votes in AP Poll

Thanks to a new policy that makes all Division I teams eligible to receive votes in the Associated Press Top 25 poll, Appalachian State University was listed on four ballots and received 19 points in voting for this week's poll on Sunday. Appalachian (2-0) is 33rd in overall voting for this week's poll, seven points ahead of Cincinnati and just four points behind Auburn. ASU returns to action next Saturday (Sept. 15) when it hosts Northern Arizona at 3:30 p.m. at Kidd Brewer Stadium.

### GSU Honors Coach Erk Russell

Georgia Southern unveiled the addition of Coach Erk Russell's name and championship years to the two retired jerseys at Paulson Stadium at halftime of the Sept. 7 game vs. West Georgia. Russell guided the Eagles to three championships, including back-to-back titles in 1985 and 1986, the first in I-AA. Georgia Southern completed the 1989 championship season undefeated and untied, earning recognition as the first 15-0 college team of the 20th century. Russell passed away one year ago.

More than 45 feet in width, the white lettering reads "Coach Erk Russell" with three footballs detailed with the years of his championship seasons. The nameplate is centered between the retired jerseys of former Eagles Tracy Ham (8) and Adrian Peterson (3).

The top four spots remained unchanged as Montana tied Massachusetts for second. New Hampshire and Furman dropped out of the Top 10 after suffering losses last weekend.

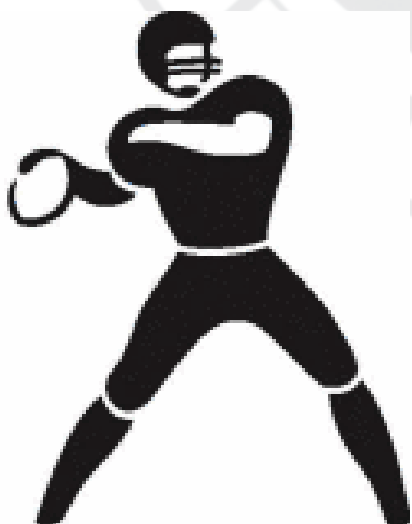
