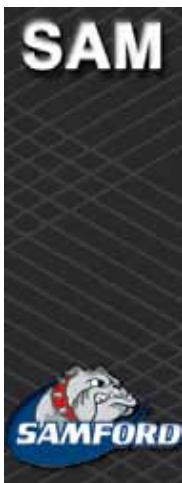

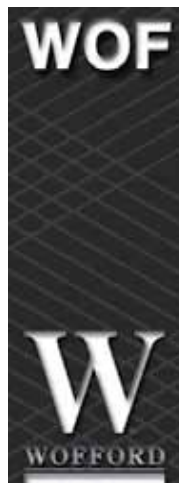

## Pitcher of the Week



**Saxon Butler, Sr., 1B, Samford**  
**.900, 2 HRs, 5 Runs, 1.700 SLG**

Butler was nearly perfect at the plate, batting .900 (9-for-10) for the opening weekend of the season. He hit two home runs, two doubles and drove in four runs in leading Samford to a series win over Radford. In the first game of the series, the first baseman went 4-for-4 at the plate while scoring twice. In game two, he was 2-for-3 with a home run, a double and two RBI. Butler went 3-for-3 with a double, a home run and two RBI in Sunday's series finale. For the weekend, the Oxford, Ala., native reached base at a .923 clip while notching a 1.700 slugging percentage.



**Eric Eck, So., RHP, Wofford**  
**1-0, 0-0 ERA, 7 K, 4.1 IP**

Eck entered Saturday's game against Dayton in the seventh inning with runners on the corners and the score tied at five. The sophomore right-hander from Buford, Ga., recorded a strike out to end the threat then followed that with four scoreless frames to pick up the win for the Terriers. Eck allowed just one hit in 4.1 innings while fanning seven of the 14 Dayton batters he faced, including five of them on called third strikes.

### A FAST START FOR THE SoCON

With a 30-11 overall record entering this weekend, the Southern Conference has raced out to one of the fastest starts of any league in the country. The league's .732 winning percentage is good for third nationally out of 32 conferences, including Independents.

### EDWARDS IS STREAKING TO THE TOP

UNCG catcher Trevor Edwards, a preseason first-team all-SoCon selection by the league's coaches, currently boasts the conference's longest hitting streak.

The junior backstop ended 2011 on a 10-game hitting streak, and he has begun 2012 just as effectively. In four games, Edwards is batting 5-for-15 (.333) with three home runs and a double for a slugging percentage of 1.000.

The longest hitting streak in SoCon history remains 29 games, a mark which is shared by College of Charleston's Billy Colome (1999) and Samford's Mason Meredeth (2009). The NCAA Division I record streak, which was set by current Chicago White Sox manager Robin Ventura at Oklahoma State in 1987, is 58 games.

### HEFFLEY HITTING HIS WAY INTO RECORD BOOKS

Western Carolina All-America second baseman Ross Heffley currently leads all active players in Division I in career hits with 280. The senior, who has totaled 92, 86, and 96 hits, respectively, in his first three seasons, needs to reach 87 hits this year to surpass The Citadel's Philip Hartig (360 hits, 1998-2001) as the conference's all-time hits leader.

Hartig's mark currently ranks as the ninth-highest total in Division I history.

## SoCon Team Notes

### APPALACHIAN STATE

- ASU has won three of its last five games versus SEC opponents heading into this weekend's series at No. 8 LSU
- ASU got its first win over a nationally ranked opponent in 29 years last February when it defeated No. 20 Miami (Fla.).

### COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON

- The Cougars completed an opening weekend sweep on the road at South Alabama.
- The CofC pitching staff allowed just three earned runs over three games.
- The series marked the first road series on the opening weekend for the Cougars since 2003.
- College of Charleston has not lost an opening game since 2005 and never in the Monte Lee era.
- Preseason All-American Daniel Aldrich hit his first home run of the season, while junior-college transfer Cody Martin hit a three-run pinch-hit HR in the eighth inning on Friday to win the game for the Cougars.

### THE CITADEL

- With six hits on the opening weekend, senior OF Nick Orvin moved into ninth place overall on The Citadel's career hits list with 260. Orvin needs seven hits to move past Jon Aughey for eighth place.
- The Citadel's 10-7 win over Richmond snapped the Bulldogs' 13-game losing streak dating back to last season.

### DAVIDSON

- Senior centerfielder Drew Gadaire was Davidson's most consistent offensive weapon in the season opening series, reaching base five times in nine plate appearances, and he was the lone Wildcat with multiple extra base hits (a double and a triple).
- Wildcat pitchers nearly matched both last season's season-low for hits and season-high for walks in a game. The 'Cats accomplished the former as RHP Brian Russell allowed just three hits in 5.0 innings, and the Wildcat bullpen combined to throw 4.0 innings of hitless ball. However, the pitchers combined to issue eight walks, three shy of last season's high of 11.
- Dating back to last season, Davidson's win over La Salle snapped a nine-game losing streak.

### ELON

- Elon's series with South Carolina will mark the second time in its NCAA Division I era that the maroon and gold has faced off with the defending national champion. In 2002 Elon won two games of a three-game set at 2001 champ Miami. In fact, the Phoenix was one out away from claiming a series sweep of the Hurricanes that year before dropping the finale 5-4. Elon won the first two games by scores of 3-2 and 11-8.
- Elon scored eight runs on just five hits in a win over North Carolina A&T. It marked the most runs that an Elon team has scored with five or fewer hits in its time as a NCAA Division I program.

### FURMAN

- With the 2012 SoCon Baseball Championship returning to the Paladins' hometown of Greenville, S.C., Furman will be looking to qualify for the event by finishing eighth or higher for the ninth straight season.
- Furman will host five games at Fluor Field this season, including matchups with Clemson, Michigan State, and two-time defending national champion South Carolina.

### GEORGIA SOUTHERN

- Victor Roache, who set a new SoCon record with 30 home runs in 2011 started the new year the same way he ended last year as he belted home runs on both Saturday and Sunday against UT Martin.
- The Eagles' pitching staff closed the opening weekend with a 1.67 ERA while striking out 27 batters in 27.0 innings of work.

### UNCG

- Catcher Trevor Edwards, who entered 2012 on a 10-game hitting streak, extended his SoCon-best streak to 13 games with a hit in each game of the series sweep versus Delaware State.
- The Spartans' 22 Southern Conference victories in 2011 were the most since 1998 when the team finished 22-5 in its first season of SoCon play.

### SAMFORD

- Samford senior first baseman Saxon Butler got the season off to a tremendous start last weekend. In three games he batted .900 (9-for-10) with two doubles, two home runs and four RBI. He has a slugging percentage of 1.700 and an on-base percentage of .923.
- Samford won its season-opening series from Radford over the weekend. The series win marks the fourth-straight season that Samford has won its season-opening series.

### WESTERN CAROLINA

- With the three wins on the weekend, Western Carolina has won four-straight opening day games and have now claimed six-straight opening weekend series including sweeping the last four, all under fifth-year head coach Bobby Moranda.
- Western Carolina will take part in the Ninth Annual Keith LeClair Classic, hosted by East Carolina in Greenville, N.C., Feb. 24-26 ... the Catamounts will face Maryland (Feb. 24), the host Pirates (Feb. 25) and Purdue (Feb. 26) in the three-day event named after former WCU and ECU head coach, Keith LeClair.

### WOFFORD

- Wofford started the season at home for the sixth-straight season.
- Freshman Matthew Kaskow had a single in his first career at-bat.
- Senior Mac Doyle is one hit away from 200 career hits. He is sixth in school history in hits.
