- Appalachian State is ranked in the *Collegiate Baseball Newspaper's* Top 30 poll for the first time in program history, coming in at 29th nationally.
- Pitching remains strong in the early part of the year with team ERAs averaging 4.16, led by CofC's 2.47 and ASU's 3.19. As a league in 2011, team ERAs averaged 4.58.

Callaway hit .522 (12-for-23) with two home runs, five doubles, eight RBIs and six runs scored in five games last week as the Mountaineers were 4-1, including a three-game SoCon sweep of The Citadel. The short-stop from Greenville, S.C., hit safely in all five games, including multiple hits in 4-of-5 contests. Callaway's three-run home run in the first inning gave the Mountaineers an early lead over No. 3 South Carolina on Wednesday. The junior was 9-of-14 against The Citadel, highlighted by a 4-for-5 effort with a home run and two doubles in Sunday's series finale.

ELON

Dylan Clark, Jr., LHP, Elon
1-0, 0.00 ERA, 4 K, 2 H, 7.0 IP

Clark ran his consecutive scoreless innings streak to 13 by tossing seven innings without a run in Elon's 10-2 win against Davidson on Saturday. The junior from Manchester, N.H., surrendered only a pair of singles to the Wildcats while fanning four and walking two. On the year, Clark is now 5-1 with a SoCon-best 1.26 ERA, allowing five earned runs in 35.2 innings on the mound.

Western Carolina All-America second baseman Ross Heffley currently leads all active players in Division I in career hits with 301. The senior, who has totaled 92, 86, and 96 hits, respectively, in his first three seasons, needs to reach 87 hits this year to surpass The Citadel's Philip Hartig (360 hits, 1998-2001) as the conference's all-time hits leader.

SoCon Team Notes

APPALACHIAN STATE

- ASU's three-game sweep of The Citadel was its first in a series that dates back to 1972 (ASU's first in the SoCon and NCAA Division I).
- ASU has won 15 of its last 16 ballgames, with its only loss coming in last Wednesday's 6-4 heartbreaker at No. 3 South Carolina.
- ASU's 6-0 conference start is its best since it won its first seven SoCon games in 1978.
- Tyler Zupcic is in the midst of an ASU season-best 13-game hitting streak.
- Daniel Kassouf homered four times in five games last week.

COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON

- Despite falling to non-conference foes UNC-Wilmington and Coastal Carolina, the Cougars bounced back with a home sweep of Wofford for the second straight SoCon weekend sweep.
- The Cougars used outstanding pitching performances from Josh Renfro and Matt Pegler on Friday and Saturday and then battled through a 4.5 hour rain delay on Sunday with several home runs, including a 3-run pinch-hit blast from Brandon Glazer, to win the Sunday game.
- Marty Gantt extended his safely reached base streak to 17 games as he hit .353 on the week with 5 RBIs and two home runs.

THE CITADEL

- The Citadel begins a week of non-conference action with a single game against Charleston Southern Tuesday evening at Riley Park, before traveling to face Big 10 foe Minnesota for a three-game set in Minneapolis this weekend.
- The Bulldogs have faced the Golden Gophers one time before, dropping a 6-3 decision at Riley Park on February 24, 2007.
- Mason Davis (Conyers, Ga.) hit his first collegiate home run in Saturday's 9-4 loss to Appalachian State. The round-tripper came in the first inning, as Davis knocked a 1-2 pitch over the wall in right to lead off the game.

DAVIDSON

- Davidson earned the series win over Elon despite twice trailing in the 11th inning. Senior centerfielder Drew Gadaire and senior right fielder Jake Berman had the walk-off hits as the 'Cats erased a two-run deficit in the 11th in the second game of a doubleheader Saturday and a one-run deficit in the 11th Sunday.
- Four out of 17 of Davidson's games this year have gone into extra innings, including three of six SoCon games. Davidson fell to Ohio and Appalachian State earlier in the year in games that went 10 innings. The Wildcats had just four extra inning games all of last season.
- Senior center fielder Drew Gadaire is the only Wildcat to reach base in each game

so far this season. Dating back to last season, his reached-base streak is now 23 consecutive games.

ELON

- Dylan Clark lowered his ERA to a league-best 1.26 with seven more scoreless innings on Saturday.
- Elon's series loss to Davidson marked the first time the Wildcats had taken a three-game set from the Phoenix since the later joined the SoCon. Davidson did win the only game in a rain-shortened series in 2009.

FURMAN

- The Paladins have won seven straight in non-league play heading into Tuesday's game against sixth-ranked South Carolina at Fluor Field.

GEORGIA SOUTHERN

- The Eagles' three-game sweep at the hands of Elon marked the first time since 2007 that they had been swept to start league play. That year, Furman took three from Georgia Southern in Statesboro.

UNCG

- UNCG's 12-9 victory at Georgia Southern on Saturday marked the Spartans' first in Statesboro since 2004.

SAMFORD

- After taking two of three from Furman over the weekend, Samford faces the difficult task of traveling to No. 1 Florida on Tuesday.

WESTERN CAROLINA

- Western Carolina went 3-1 on the week last week, winning at home on Wednesday over former head coach Jack Leggett and the Clemson Tigers to stretch its home winning streak to 12-straight dating back to last season.
- WCU steps out of conference on Wednesday, visiting historic McCormick Field to play UNC Asheville looking to snap a two-game slide against its mountain-rival. The Catamounts host UNCG for a three-game SoCon set next weekend, looking to halt a three-game slide against the Spartans after being swept a season ago on the road.

WOFFORD

- The team batting average is .262 after 20 games and the team ERA is 4.85. Last season the batting average was .265 and the team ERA was 5.12.
- In the three game series at the College of Charleston, Wofford committed only one error. The Terriers have 45 on the season, while opponents have committed only 24.
- Wofford was the final team to open SoCon play.
