- Davidson freshman Henry Sisson pitched the first SoCon no-hitter since 2004 as he blanked Wofford, 1-0, on Friday. It was the first complete game no-hitter by a pitcher since The Citadel's T.A. Fulmer accomplished the feat against ETSU in 2002. The year prior was Davidson's last no-no, a nine-inning gem by Wes Self versus High Point.
- With each SoCon team now at or beyond the midway point in conference play, four teams are tied by percentage atop the league standings. Appalachian State, College of Charleston, Elon and Western Carolina have all won two-thirds of their SoCon games. ASU and WCU have five series remaining while Elon has four and CofC three.
- With 10 non-conference victories over nationally-ranked opponents, the SoCon has its most wins over ranked teams since 2009 when league teams won 19 overall and 13 in non-conference play.
- After going nearly three years without two SoCon teams defeating a ranked opponent in the same day, it has already happened twice this season on March 27 (GSU def. #21 Georgia Tech, 5-3 and Samford def. #24 Auburn, 8-5) and April 17 (CofC def. #6 South Carolina, 4-3 and Furman def. #26 Georgia, 5-4).

Bradley Goodson, Jr., SS, Coll. of Charleston
.692, 5 Runs, 8 RBI, 1 HR, 1.000 SLG

Goodson had nine hits in four games last week as College of Charleston went 3-1 to move into a four-way tie for first place in the SoCon standings. The junior from Jacksonville, Fla., started the week with a 4-for-4, five RBI effort in the Cougars' 16-3 rout of Winthrop. Over the weekend, he added five hits, including a pair of doubles, as CofC took two-of-three from Samford. For the week, Goodson hit .692 with a home run and two doubles while driving in eight runs and scoring five.

DAV

Henry Sisson, Fr., LHP, Davidson
1-0, 0.00 ERA, No-Hitter, 9 K, 3 BB, 9.0 IP

Sisson threw the sixth no-hitter in Davidson history Friday night and the first since 2001 as the Wildcats shut out Wofford, 1-0. The milestone came in just Sisson's fifth career start as he upped his record to 2-1. The freshman from Chevy Chase, Md., allowed four base runners on three walks and an error and matched his career high of nine strikeouts. The no-hitter was the first in the SoCon since College of Charleston combined to blank Western Carolina in 2004, and it was the first complete game no-hitter by a starter since The Citadel's T.A. Fulmer shut down East Tennessee State in 2002.

SoCon Team Notes

APPALACHIAN STATE

- Appalachian is 17-1 at home this season after dropping the series finale to Charleston last Sunday. The streak was ASU's longest since it won 19-straight games at Smith Stadium from March 22, 2009-March 20, 2010.

COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON

- College of Charleston snapped a streak of losing the last two SoCon series by defeating Samford in two out of three games.
- On the week, the Cougars averaged 12.25 hits per game, as Daniel Aldrich and Bradley Goodson posted outstanding performances. Aldrich came out of his hitting slump to tally multiple hits in each game and score eight runs on the week. Goodson hit .692 with 8 RBI to grab the team lead with 31.

THE CITADEL

- Head Coach Fred Jordan picked up his 700th career victory in Friday's 3-0 victory over UNCG. Jordan becomes the 36th active member of the 700-win club of NCAA Division I head coaches. In his 21st season, Jordan is 702-529 all-time at the helm of the Citadel program.
- Austin Pritcher's complete-game shutout of UNCG Friday night was the first for The Citadel since Matt Talley did it on May 15, 2010, also against UNCG.
- The Bulldogs sweep of UNCG was the team's first SoCon sweep since the Bulldogs took all three from Appalachian State on March 4-5, 2011.

DAVIDSON

- Freshman LHP Henry Sisson threw the sixth no-hitter in Davidson history Friday night and the first since 2001 (Wes Self). It was just Sisson's fifth career start. He allowed four base runners (three walks, one error) and matched his career high of nine strikeouts.
- Senior RHP Ryan Overcash also threw his first career complete game, striking out a career-high 11 on Saturday. Prior to the weekend, Davidson had just two complete games in the past four years. LHP Chris Lamb, who was drafted by the Oakland A's following his junior season in 2011, threw both with one coming last season and the other in 2010.
- Davidson's sweep of Wofford was its first in a three-game SoCon series since 2009 against UNCG

ELON

- Out of its first 35 games of the season, Elon played 16 contests against top-30 foes.
- The Phoenix has played seven extra inning games this season, going 4-3 in those outings.
- Junior lefty Dylan Clark picked up his SoCon-leading seventh win of the season on Friday.

FURMAN

- Furman's win over No. 26 Georgia on Tuesday snapped a five-game losing streak, and it was Furman's third victory against the Bulldogs in the past four meetings.

GEORGIA SOUTHERN

- After starting 3-6 in SoCon play, the Eagles have won three consecutive series and 7 of 9 games to improve to 10-8.

UNCG

- UNCG leads the nation in sacrifice bunts with 62 on the year.
- Zach Leach is on a 10-game hitting streak and Kris Richards is on an 11-game hitting streak.
- Following a sweep from the hands of The Citadel, UNCG was swept for the first time in a three-game series since May 20-22, 2010 when Furman accomplished the feat.

SAMFORD

- Samford senior right fielder Brandon Miller is closing in on the school's single-season home run record. Miller now has 14 home runs this season, tying him for third all-time. The school record is 17 set by Jim Morgan in 1997. Last season, Miller hit 16 homers, the second-highest single-season total.
- Samford senior pitcher Josh Martin has won 18 games in his career at Samford, tying him with Glen Criswell (1994-97) for the school record in the category.

WESTERN CAROLINA

- Coming off a rare bye-week with no games schedule mid-week, Western Carolina swept the Furman Paladins for the first-time since 2010, winning 3-0, 9-2 and 11-5 in Cullowhee. WCU stretched its home win streak over the Paladins to six-straight. The Catamounts improved to 16-3 at home at Childress Field / Hennon Stadium this season. The Catamounts have also already surpassed last year's win total (23) for the entire season.
- Junior reliever Preston Hatcher already has seven saves on the season to rank him tied for eighth in the school's single-season record books in the category. The most saves for a Catamount pitcher in a single season is 14 by Mike Manning in 1994.

WOFFORD

- Last season Wofford earned a series sweep by winning three one-run games. This season it was Davidson earning the sweep, again with three one-run games.
- Wofford has 19 home runs already this season, which matches the total number hit in the 2011 season.
- Against Davidson on Friday night, Brandon Yarusi threw his second straight complete game, allowing only one run. He has given up one run in his last 21 innings.
