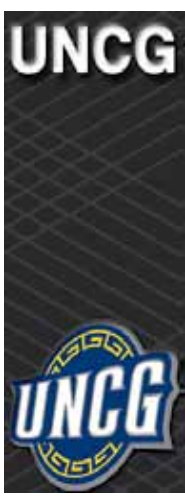

- UNCG is one of just 14 teams nationwide to remain unbeaten through the first two weeks of the season. Dating back to last year, the Spartans are 22-3 in their last 25 games.
- Pitching remains strong in the early part of the year with team ERAs average 3.84, led by CofC's 1.38 and ASU's 1.73.
- Samford's Saxon Butler leads the league in batting at .567 (17-for-30).

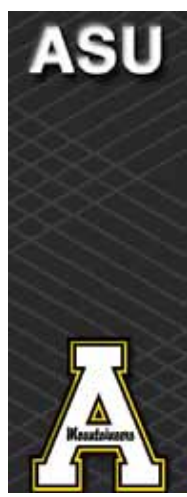

## Player of the Week Pitcher of the Week



**Thomas Troelstrup, Sr., 3B, UNCG**  
**.500, 3 2B, 1 HR, 7 RBIs, 5 Runs**

Troelstrup was a catalyst at the plate as the Spartans went 4-0 and moved their record to 7-0 on the season. Troelstrup hit .500 for the week as he batted 9-for-18 at the plate against UNC Asheville and Penn State. The third baseman from Tallahassee, Fla., had three doubles and a home run on the week and also added seven RBIs and five runs scored. He was 2-for-5 against UNC Asheville on Tuesday and 3-for-5 on both Friday and Saturday against Penn State.



**Ryan Arrowood, Sr., RHP, Appalachian State**  
**1-0, 0-0 ERA, 10 K, 2 H, 7.0 IP**

Arrowood turned in a stellar performance as he pitched seven shutout innings to beat No. 7 LSU, 1-0, on Saturday. The senior right-hander retired 16 straight batters after facing a two-on, no-out jam in the first. He struck out five in a row twice during that stretch as the Rutherfordton, N.C., native retired 20 of the final 21 batters he faced and 20-of-23 overall. In total, Arrowood allowed just two hits and one walk and matched a career high with 10 strikeouts, as the Mountaineers became the first non-conference team to shutout the Tigers in nearly eight years.

### A FAST START FOR THE SoCON

With a 47-27 overall record entering this weekend, the Southern Conference has raced out to one of the fastest starts of any league in the country. The league's .635 winning percentage is good for sixth nationally out of 32 conferences, including Independents.

### RICHARDS, BUTLER ARE STREAKING TO THE TOP

UNCG second baseman Kris Richards and Samford first baseman Saxon Butler enter the week with the league's longest current hitting streaks.

Richards has hit in nine streak dating back to last year and currently boasts a team-high .500 (10-for-20) average with 2 HRs and 9 RBIs. Butler, last week's SoCon player of the week, is batting .567 (17-for-30) with 2 HRs and 11 RBIs and has two or more hits in six of Samford's eight games thus far.

The longest hitting streak in SoCon history remains 29 games, a mark which is shared by College of Charleston's Billy Colome (1999) and Samford's Mason Meredeth (2009). The NCAA Division I record streak, which was set by current Chicago White Sox manager Robin Ventura at Oklahoma State in 1987, is 58 games.

### HEFFLEY HITTING HIS WAY INTO RECORD BOOKS

Western Carolina All-America second baseman Ross Heffley currently leads all active players in Division I in career hits with 280. The senior, who has totaled 92, 86, and 96 hits, respectively, in his first three seasons, needs to reach 87 hits this year to surpass The Citadel's Philip Hartig (360 hits, 1998-2001) as the conference's all-time hits leader.

## SoCon Team Notes

### APPALACHIAN STATE

- After going 29 years without a victory over a nationally ranked opponent, Appalachian has now won three of its last five games versus ranked foes (Saturday and Sunday vs. LSU, Feb. 25, 2011 vs. No. 20 Miami (Fla.)).
- The Mountaineers are 5-2 in their last seven games versus clubs from the baseball-rich Southeastern Conference.
- The last time that LSU had scored as few as five runs in a three-game series was May 17-19, 2007 when it managed only five runs in a three-game sweep at Vanderbilt ... the Tigers hadn't been limited to as few as five runs in a home series since it scored only three runs in three games versus Ole Miss in 1982.

### COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON

- After losing to Rhode Island, the Cougars bounced back in the Cougar Invitational with wins over UConn and Xavier.
- The Cougar pitching staff allowed just six earned runs and an opponent batting average of .184 over the entire weekend.
- Matt Pegler went the first 6.1 innings without allowing a hit on Sunday and finished with seven innings, no runs and one hit. Christian Powell had a strong start on Saturday, holding UConn, a 2011 Super Regional team, to just one run and four hits in five innings.

### THE CITADEL

- The Bulldogs stretched their pitching staff in the four-game series against Delaware, using all 12 pitchers on the staff over the four days. The staff posted a 2.75 ERA over the weekend, splitting the series 2-2.
- Bo Thompson hit his first collegiate home run, a three-run shot, in the first inning of the 12-8 win over Delaware Saturday afternoon. Zach Sherrill picked up his first collegiate save in the game, pitching 1.2 innings of shutout relief.

### DAVIDSON

- Davidson's bullpen has thrown 12-straight scoreless innings, dating back to the second game of the season on Feb. 18, a win over La Salle. Four of the seven relievers the 'Cats have used this season are freshmen.
- The 'Cats surpassed their 2011 season high of five stolen bases in a game by swiping six against Lehigh Feb. 25. Davidson then stole four Feb. 26 vs. Fairleigh Dickinson, giving the 'Cats 10 stolen bases in 10 attempts in two games.
- Senior second baseman James Cerbie is the lone Wildcat to record a hit in each of the five games this season. Senior centerfielder Drew Gadaire is one of four Wildcats to reach base in each game so far this season, and has a streak of 11 straight games dating back to last season.

### ELON

- Elon is in the midst of a seven-game road swing, one of three stretches of at least six in a row away from Latham Park this season.

- The maroon and gold's meeting with High Point this week will be the 200th all-time match-up between the two programs. Elon has faced High Point more than any other team and leads the series 119-80.
- The Phoenix will open up SoCon play at College of Charleston this weekend. Elon has never lost its SoCon opener or its league-opening series since joining the SoCon for the 2004 season.

### FURMAN

- With the 2012 SoCon Baseball Championship returning to the Paladins' hometown of Greenville, S.C., Furman will be looking to qualify for the event by finishing eighth or higher for the ninth straight season.

### GEORGIA SOUTHERN

- Georgia Southern dropped just their second game of the season but picked up their second weekend series win in as many tries with a doubleheader sweep of Radford. The Eagles will have to go deep into the pitching staff this week with five games. GSU hosts Mercer on Tuesday and travels for the first time on Thursday to North Florida.
- Eric Phillips continues to climb his way up the Eagles career hitting lists. Phillips ranks 10th in career batting average after hitting .433 with five doubles and 12 RBIs in seven games this year.

### UNCG

- UNCG's 7-0 start is its best since the 2003 squad raced out to a 12-0 mark to begin the season. That was also the best start in school history.
- The Spartans' 22 Southern Conference victories in 2011 were the most since 1998 when the team finished 22-5 in its first season of SoCon play.

### SAMFORD

- Samford senior right fielder Brandon Miller hit four more home runs last week to bring his season total to six homers in the first eight games of the season. Last season, Miller led Samford with 16 home runs, just one shy of the school single-season record.
- Through the first eight games of the season, Samford has hit 14 home runs as a team, while the Bulldogs' pitching staff has allowed just one home run.

### WESTERN CAROLINA

- Western Carolina entered the three-games at the Keith LeClair Classic averaging 14.3 hits a game through its first four outings. However, the Catamounts struggled offensively at the Keith LeClair Classic averaging just 5.3 hits in the three games.

### WOFFORD

- The Terriers are hitting .299 as a team so far this season.
- Sophomore Luke Feisal hit his first career home run in the 8-7 win over Pittsburgh as he drove in three runs.
- Senior Mac Doyle reached 200 career hits in the win at Gardner-Webb.
