Quick Hits

• The Citadel and Chattanooga finished league play with identical 6-1 records. Chattanooga earned the SoCon's bid to the FCS Playoffs by virtue of its win over the Bulldogs on Nov. 14.

• Home teams are 12-13 in conference play this season and are 48-38 since the start of 2013.

• Twelve of the 25 league games this season have been decided by one possession. Nine of the 28 league games were decided by one possession last year and 16 of the SoCon's 36 league games were decided by one possession in 2013.

RANKINGS: The Chattanooga Mocs and Citadel Bulldogs are ranked in both weekly FCS polls. UTC is ranked eighth in the STATS, LLC., poll and ninth by the FCS coaches. The Citadel is ranked No. 24 in the coaches poll, and No. 25 in the STATS LLC poll.

• Western Carolina is among the teams receiving votes.

AWARD CANDIDATES: The Southern Conference has two players on the STATS Offensive Player of the Year Watch List and three on the Defensive Player of the Year Watch List.

• Offensive Player of the Year - Jacob Huesman (Chattanooga) and Troy Mitchell (Western Carolina).

CONFERENCE CROWN: The Citadel and Chattanooga finished the regular season with identical 6-1 records in league play and are co-champions for 2015. It is The Citadel's first conference title since 1992. It is the third straight season the Mocs have won at least a share of the Southern Conference championship.

- By virtue of a 31-21 win over The Citadel on Nov. 14, Chattanooga earned the league's automatic bid to the FCS Playoffs.

THE FRIENDLY CONFINES OF HOME: Southern Conference teams are 13-4 at home in nonconference games this season.

- SoCon teams were 15-4 at home in 2014 and went 8-7 in 2013. League teams finished 13-2 at home in nonconference play during 2012 after going 15-1 in 2011. SoCon teams own a record of 75-21 (.781) in nonconference home games since the start of the 2010 season.

GROUND ATTACK: A Southern Conference team has ranked either first or second nationally in rushing in 13 of the last 14 seasons.

- The Citadel ranks second in the nation with 343.7 yards per game on the ground.

BROKEN RECORDS: Southern Conference teams have turned in record-setting performances during the regular season in 2015:

- Davidson at The Citadel - September 5
 The Citadel's 69-point win was tied for the sixth-highest margin of victory in league history.
 The Citadel's 10 TDs was tied for the eighth best mark in league history.
- Career Touchdowns
 Chattanooga's Jacob Huesman has thrown 59 career touchdown passes which is tied for the third-highest total all-time.
- VMI vs. Wofford - October 31
 Al Cobb passed for 370 yards against the Terriers. Cobb's ten career 300-plus yard passing games are tied for third in SoCon history.

BUCS ARE BACK: ETSU has restarted football for the 2015 season. The Bucs will compete as an independent in FCS football this season and return to Southern Conference play in 2016.

- ETSU competed in the league from 1978 through 2003 before dropping the program.
- The Bucs' best season in the SoCon was the 1996 campaign when ETSU went 10-3 overall with a 7-1 record in league play. The Bucs defeated Villanova (35-29) in the opening round of the FCS playoffs before falling at Montana (44-14) in the quarterfinals.

WORKING OVERTIME: Southern Conference teams are 29-38 (.438) all-time in overtime games. The most recent overtime game was Nov. 14, 2015, Mercer topped Furman (27-20).

EXPERIENCED COACHES: Wofford head coach Mike Ayers is the dean of SoCon coaches. Ayers has tallied 140 wins at ETSU and Wofford while coaching in the Southern Conference. He ranks third on the league's all-time wins list behind Appalachian State's Jerry Moore and Duke's Wallace Wade. Mercer's Bobby Lamb is fourth on the all-time wins list with 78.

FBS WINS: Southern Conference teams have combined for 28 wins over FBS programs dating back to 1982.

- The league earned three FBS wins each during the 1983 and 2013 seasons.
- Furman topped UCF 16-15, on September 19.

MAKING THE GRADE: In addition to achieving success on the gridiron, SoCon teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in May, Southern Conference football teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 968, ranking third nationally and second among FCS conferences. It was the sixth consecutive season that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate for Division I.

- Ten Southern Conference's sports (football, basketball, men's cross country, men's indoor track and field, men's outdoor track and field, wrestling, women's cross country, women's indoor and outdoor track and volleyball) topped the national average in Division I.
- A total of 35 SoCon teams representing eight different schools earned the Public Recognition Award from the NCAA. The award is given to teams ranking in the top 10 percent of APR scores in Division I.
- Sixty-six Southern Conference football players were named to the league's all-academic team last fall. To qualify for the all-academic team, a student-athlete must carry a 3.3 GPA and appear in at least 50 percent of his team's games. Mercer placed a league-high 14 student-athletes on the all-academic team, while Wofford had 13 honorees.

CAUGHT IN THE DRAFT: The Southern Conference had two players taken in the 2015 NFL Draft. It was the 11th straight year the SoCon had at least one player taken in the draft.

- Samford's Jaquiski Tartt (DB) was chosen in the second round (#46) by the San Francisco 49ers. It was the second time in four years that the SoCon had a player drafted in the second round, as Appalachian State's Brian Quick was selected No. 33 overall by the St. Louis Rams in 2012.
- Chattanooga defensive lineman Davis Tull was selected in the fifth round by the New Orleans Saints with the 148th overall pick. Tull was named the league's Defensive Player of the Year each of his last three seasons at UTC.

RETURN SPECIALIST: Mercer's Chandler Curtis returned three punts for touchdowns in 2014 and is one more away from trying for the league's career high.

- Marshall Tim Martin (1993-96) and The Citadel's Carlos Frank (1996-98) each finished their career with four punt returns for touchdowns.

SOPHOMORE STANDOUT: Chattanooga's Corey Levin won the league's Jacobs Blocking Award, given to the league's best offensive lineman, as a sophomore in 2014.

- The last sophomore to win the award was Georgia Southern's Mark Williams, who won it in 1997 and 1998.
- The Jacobs Blocking Award is the oldest football award in the conference, dating back to 1933.
