CONFERENCE NEWS AND NOTES

• Six Southern Conference teams are in action Saturday, and five of the league's six opponents are ranked in the top 25 in either the USILA or Inside Lacrosse polls.

• Among those opponents is No. 2 Duke, which visits Jacksonville. High Point pulled off the biggest upset of the young season Wednesday night, stunning the Blue Devils in Durham, North Carolina, 13-9. Chris Young scored four goals, Ben Baker had three, Asher Nolting had two goals and three assists and keeper Tim Troutner Jr. made 19 saves. The win moved the Panthers, who opened their season with a 13-0 shut-out of St. Bonaventure, to 2-0 on the year.

• The Dolphins, who opened their season with a 9-8 loss to Detroit Mercy on Feb. 2, will be the third straight SoCon team to face Duke. Furman opened its season against the second-ranked Blue Devils on Feb. 2, falling 17-9. Jacksonville faced four ranked opponents last season, dropping three of those contests by just one goal.

• Furman continues its daunting early schedule when it visits No. 13 North Carolina on Saturday. The Paladins dropped a 15-14 contest in overtime to the then-9th-ranked Tar Heels last season. The squads have met every year since Furman's inaugural season of 2014.

• In total, SoCon teams are scheduled this season to play 18 games against 11 teams ranked in either the USILA or Inside Lacrosse preseason polls. Air Force received votes in the USILA poll, while Jacksonville did in the Inside Lacrosse poll.

• Bellarmine visits No. 19 Marquette in a matchup with a couple of intriguing story lines. Last season, the Knights upset then-No. 18 Marquette, 7-6 in double overtime. In goal for Bellarmine that day was freshman John Hulsman, who made 13 saves and would earn first-team All-SoCon honors at the end of the season. Hulsman, however, transferred in the offseason and is now a Golden Eagle, starting two of Marquette's preseason scrimmages, and will face his old team in his first official game with his new one.

• Preseason SoCon favorite Richmond opens its season at No. 3 Maryland on Saturday. The Spiders' Teddy Hatfield enters his senior season as the league's career leader in points (154) and assists (67). He's two back of the goals record with 87.

• Air Force opens its fourth season in the SoCon at longtime rival No. 8 Denver on Saturday. Bill Wilson makes his debut as the Falcons head coach after serving as the interim head coach last season. The Falcons put three players on the preseason All-SoCon team.

• Mercer visits Utah, which opened its inaugural season with a 21-6 loss to Vermont on Feb. 1. The Bears opened the season with a 20-9 loss to No. 13 North Carolina in Roswell, Georgia.

• High Point and Richmond shared the league regular-season title in 2018. The title was the first for HPU, while the Spiders claimed their third in the SoCon's four seasons of sponsoring men's lacrosse. Richmond would go on to win its first SoCon tournament after losing in the title game in the previous three years.
