## CONFERENCE NEWS AND NOTES

• All eight Southern Conference teams are in action this week, with Jacksonville hosting Marquette on Friday before the remaining seven teams play Saturday.

• After opening the season with a 13-0 shutout of St. Bonaventure and a 13-9 win at No. 2 Duke, High Point jumped into the national rankings this week. The Panthers debuted at No. 13 in the Inside Lacrosse and US Lacrosse Magazine polls – the highest ranking in program history – and at No. 16 in the USILA poll.

• Preseason SoCon favorite Richmond fell just short in its upset bid of No. 3 Maryland on Feb. 9, scoring the final five goals in a 10-9 loss. Ryan Lanchbury scored a career-high five goals, including the Spiders' last four. Richmond is receiving votes in the USILA poll after that showing.

• Richmond senior Teddy Hatfield scored twice in the loss to Maryland, matching the SoCon record for career goals with 89. Hatfield also holds (solo) the league's career records for points (158) and assists (69).

• VMI opens its season Saturday when it hosts Manhattan. The Keydets return first-team All-SoCon defenseman Kyle Walsh, who finished second in the NCAA in caused turnovers per game (2.62), and leading scorers Ryan Perouty (29 goals, 33 points) and John Daniel (26 goals, 31 points). In addition, second-team All-SoCon faceoff specialist AJ Krstulovic returns after finishing second in the league in faceoff percentage in 2018 (.596; 118-of-198).

• Air Force and Mercer host their home openers Saturday. The Falcons welcome Marist for a 2 p.m. Eastern showdown, and the Bears will face Canisius at 1 p.m.

HIGH POINT'S ASHER NOLTING

### OFFENSE

#### Asher Nolting, High Point, So., A

A sophomore attackman from Greenwood Village, Colorado, Nolting totaled 12 points for the week, opening the season with three goals and four assists in a 13-0 win over St. Bonaventure before adding two goals and three assists in a 13-9 victory over No. 2 Duke. The reigning SoCon Offensive Player of the Year and Freshman of the Year, Nolting has scored at least two points in all 16 of his career games and is already eighth in league history in career assists (43).

### DEFENSE

#### Tim Troutner Jr., High Point, Sr., GK

Troutner logged a 4.79 goals against average, 25 total saves and a .735 save percentage in his first two games of the season. The senior goalkeeper from Annapolis, Maryland, had six saves in 53 minutes of action against St. Bonaventure to lead the Panthers to the first shutout in program history. Troutner followed that up with 19 saves, including seven in the third quarter, and allowed just nine goals in the win over Duke, facing 41 shots on the day. The program record-holder with 20 career wins, Troutner is second in NCAA Division I in GAA this season.

## CONFERENCE NEWS AND NOTES

• After Mercer faces Canisius on Saturday, Furman will host the Golden Griffins on Tuesday. Air Force visits Canisius on March 2.

• In addition to earning SoCon player of the week honors Tuesday, High Point's Asher Nolting and Tim Troutner Jr. earned spots on the USILA Team of the Week.

• High Point redshirt senior attackman Chris Young scored the game-winning goals against both St. Bonaventure and Duke. He has eight goals on the young season after scoring four times in each contest.

• Furman junior goalkeeper Alec Van de Bovenkamp had a school-record 20 saves in the Paladins' 14-10 loss at then-No. 13 North Carolina on Feb. 9. Sophomore attackman Jarrett Birch matched his career high with four goals against the Tar Heels.

• Bellarmine visits Cleveland State on Saturday. In last season's meeting, the Knights' Luke Legnard scored just seven seconds into the eventual 13-9 win.

• Furman takes on Sacred Heart in a neutral-site contest at Radnor High School in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, on Saturday. The Paladins dropped neutral-site contests to the Pioneers in Baltimore, Maryland, in each of the two previous years.

• After facing Drexel on Saturday, High Point heads to Virginia to face the 11th-ranked Cavaliers on Monday.
