## CONFERENCE NEWS AND NOTES

• Seven of the eight Southern Conference teams return to action this weekend, highlighted by Richmond hosting No. 5 Notre Dame on Saturday. Jacksonville hosts Michigan, which is receiving votes in the national polls.

• High Point continued its hot start by knocking off its second ranked opponent of the season on Feb. 18. The Panthers got four goals from Asher Nolting and 17 saves from Tim Troutner Jr. as they handed No. 9 Virginia a 14-13 setback. High Point downed then-No. 2 earlier in the season to jump into the national rankings.

• The Panthers are ranked No. 11 in the Nike/US Lacrosse Magazine and Inside Lacrosse polls and No. 13 in the USILA poll.

• Preseason SoCon favorite Richmond has won two straight, downing Bucknell and UMBC. Teddy Hatfield has scored seven goals and assisted on seven more in those games, while Ryan Lanchbury has scored 11 points on nine goals and two assists in that span.

• VMI downed Manhattan 11-10 on Feb. 16 to win its first season opener in 19 years. The Keydets last started 1-0 in 2000, when they topped Virginia Tech 9-7 to open the campaign.

• Trey Lervick scored four goals and Brandon Jones had five ground balls and two caused turnovers as Air Force earned its first win of the season on Feb. 16, 12-6 over Marist.

• Furman downed Canisius on Feb. 19 for its first win of the season. Jarret Birch had three goals and an assist.

HIGH POINT'S ASHER NOLTING

### OFFENSE

#### Asher Nolting, High Point, So., A

Nolting had six goals and three assists for nine points on the week. In a 15-14 overtime win over Drexel, the sophomore attackman from Greenwood Village, Colorado, scored twice and assisted on three goals, including on the tying score with 5:29 left in regulation and on the game-winner with 41 seconds left in OT. Against No. 9 Virginia, Nolting matched his career high with four goals. Nolting has scored at least two points in all 18 of his career games and is already sixth in league history in career assists (46).

### DEFENSE

#### Tim Troutner Jr., High Point, Sr., GK

Troutner averaged 15 saves and posted a 13.14 goals against average on the week, turning in a save percentage of .526 and playing every minute in goal in the two wins. He also averaged 4.0 ground balls and 2.0 caused turnovers per game. The senior goalkeeper from Annapolis, Maryland, faced 50 shots against Drexel, making 13 saves on the day. Two days later, he faced 45 shots and made 17 saves in the win over Virginia, picking up his second win over an ACC program and his second top-10 win of the season. He had five ground balls in the contest. Already the league's career saves leader (525), Troutner extended his school record for wins to 22.

## CONFERENCE NEWS AND NOTES

• Jacksonville hosts Michigan on Saturday looking for its first win the season. The Dolphins have dropped three straight to open the season, with the last two coming against No. 2 Duke and No. 19 Marquette. Evan Tyler scored five goals and added one assist for a career-high six points against Marquette on Feb. 15.

• Bellarmine visits Robert Morris on Saturday. The teams have met in 13 of the last 14 seasons, with the Knights holding an 8-5 series lead. The Colonials have won two straight after Bellarmine's four-game winning streak in the series.

• Mercer dropped a 13-10 decision to Canisius on Feb. 16, as the Golden Griffins outscored the Bears 6-1 in the fourth quarter to escape with the win. Pascal Coombs and John Tarver each scored two goals for Mercer.

• Richmond's Teddy Hatfield is the SoCon's career leader in goals (96), assists (76) and points (172). With his three goals against UMBC on Feb. 19, he moved into a tie for the SoCon's career lead in hat tricks with 15.

• High Point's Asher Nolting now qualifies for the SoCon's career points-per-game record and holds the top spot by a wide margin. The sophomore is the league's career leader with 4.83 points per game, well ahead of the 3.56 career average posted by former leader Chris Walsch (Air Force).
