## CONFERENCE NEWS AND NOTES

• All eight Southern Conference teams are in action this weekend, starting with Richmond hosting nationally ranked Duke on Friday.

• The SoCon boasts two teams in the national rankings, as Richmond jumped in on Tuesday after beating No. 6 Notre Dame 9-8 on Feb. 23. The Spiders entered at No. 16 in the USILA poll, No. 14 in the Inside Lacrosse poll and No. 11 in the Nike/US Lacrosse Magazine poll.

• High Point, which suffered its first loss of the season on Feb. 23, falling 10-9 to St. John's, moved to No. 13 in the USILA poll, No. 11 in the Inside Lacrosse poll and up three spots to No. 8 in the Nike/US Lacrosse Magazine.

• VMI topped NJIT 15-8 on Feb. 23 to move to 2-0 for the first time since the 2000 season.

• Furman set several SoCon records in its 26-6 win over Hampton on Feb. 24. The Paladins set new league marks for team goals and team points (42) and matched the record for assists (16). Fifteen different players scored for Furman, which got four goals each from David Williamson and Jimmy Harrington. Thirteen players logged at least one assist, with Seamus McFarland pacing the squad with three.

• This weekend's slate features several familiar faces. Duke has already faced Furman, High Point and Jacksonville; Robert Morris has taken on Bellarmine; Drexel has faced High Point; Utah has taken on Air Force and Mercer; Detroit Mercy has played Jacksonville; Cleveland State has faced Air Force and Bellarmine; and Canisius has played Furman and Mercer. VMI's opponent, Mount St. Mary's, is the only new foe this weekend.

## PLAYERS OF THE WEEK (FEB. 26)



**RICHMOND'S RYAN LANCHBURY**

### OFFENSE

#### Ryan Lanchbury, Richmond, So., A

Lanchbury scored nine points on eight goals and an assist on the week. In a 17-12 win over UMBC, the sophomore attackman matched his career high with five goals, adding an assist for a six-point day. Lanchbury followed that up with three goals in a 9-8 win over No. 6 Notre Dame, giving him at least three scores in all four games this season. The Burlington, Ontario, Canada, native has scored 17 goals this season, a program record through four games, and is already over halfway to the school's singles-season record of 33.

### DEFENSE

#### Sean Menges, Richmond, Jr., D

Menges collected four ground balls and caused three turnovers on the week, adding an assist on the offensive end of the field against UMBC. Perhaps more importantly, the junior defenseman from Richmond, Virginia, was tasked with defending both UMBC's and Notre Dame's top opposing midfielders and held both below their season averages. Against the Fighting Irish, in a game decided by just one score, he held Bryan Costabile, who scored five times in a season-opening win over Detroit Mercy, to just two goals.

## CONFERENCE NEWS AND NOTES

• Bellarmine goalkeeper Jordan Dondoyano faced 64 shots and made 21 saves in the Knights' 15-7 loss to Robert Morris on Feb. 23. His saves mark was the fourth-best in a game in SoCon history.

• Jacksonville dropped an 11-10 decision to Michigan on Feb. 23 in front of the more than 4,300 fans in attendance and a national audience on CBS Sports.

• VMI's Ryan Perouty scored eight points in the Keydets' 15-8 win over NJIT on Feb. 23, scoring two goals and dishing off six assists.

• Richmond's Ryan Lanchbury has notched a hat trick in all four games this season and has 17 goals on the year.

• Furman's William Holcomb is just one point from becoming the 10th player in SoCon history with 100 career points. The senior has 67 goals and 32 assists to his credit and needs one more goal to enter the league's top 10 in that category.

• Air Force senior Trent Harper is just four faceoff wins from becoming the third player in SoCon history with 400 for his career.

• High Point's Asher Nolting has scored at least two points in all 19 games of his career. He has 91 career points on 42 points and 49 assists. Panthers senior Chris Young has scored at least one goal in 17 straight games and has 32 goals over the streak.
